Your dashboard is the home base for everything you save and generate. It includes:

- **Students** — add the children you support and tag resources to them.

- **Folders** — organize resources into named collections.
- **Pathways** — guided multi-step workflows (lesson planning, family reports, intervention).

Add the students you support, choose grade levels, and pick a subject focus so the platform can surface relevant resources first.

Issue: I can't sign in.

Use Forgot Password to reset, or try the Google sign-in option. If the issue persists, contact support.

Issue: A resource won't download.

Disable popup blockers for the site, then try again. On mobile, hold the download link and choose Save to Files.

Issue: AI tools are slow.

Generation can take up to a minute for long lessons. Avoid refreshing — the result will appear when ready.

Issue: My dashboard is empty.

If you just signed up, generate or save a resource to populate your library. Use the Pathways tab for guided starts.

Support resources

- Knowledge Center — guides and how-to articles.
- FAQ section — see Section 15.
- Contact form — /contact for direct support.
